Course Description:

Just before He ascended into heaven, Jesus commissioned the Body of Christ to make disciples of the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit (Matt 28:18-20). Throughout the history of the church, however, there has been widespread disagreement over the proper meaning, mode, and even subjects of water baptism. The goal of this class is to understand clearly what Scripture teaches about these issues and come to a biblical understanding of the significance of this ordinance. Because paedobaptism is so pervasive in many segments of the Protestant church today, special attention will be given to providing a biblical critique of the teaching of infant baptism.
